Motion for Preliminary Approval of Class Settlement (the "Motion"), along with the Class Action Settlement Agreement; all attached notices, complaints, and Notice of Class Action Settlement; and all other papers, it is hereby ORDERED THAT:


1. The Motion is hereby granted. The Class Action Settlement in the Motion and set forth in the Class Action Settlement Agreement are preliminarily approved, based upon the Court's determination that the settlement is fair and adequate to the Class's interests.

2. As provided in the settlement agreement, the parties shall provide notice to Class members by locating the Class members through personal knowledge, Prestige's records, and the use of nationwide search services.
3. The Notice of Class Action Settlement fairly and accurately reflects the terms of the settlement agreement, and adequately informs the Class members of their rights and responsibilities, including the rights to opt-out or object.
4. The Notice of Class Action Settlement, and all other attached notices, are approved.
5. The Court finds the notice plan, as described in the Motion, constitutes the best method of providing notice to the Class members who can be reasonably identified pursuant to Pa. R. Civ. P. 1714(c).
6. The Court approves of the Claim Form and the use of such form to identify Class members and to distribute settlement payments.
7. The Court approves Community Justice Project as an administrator and approves them to select an administrator to serve as a joint administrator of the class fund.
8. The Court sets the Final Approval and Fairness hearing to be held at
