
**ORDER**

Upon consideration of the Plaintiffs' Motion for Service Awards, Attorneys' Fees and Costs, IT IS ORDERED this 2<sup>nd</sup> day of April, 2019 that

1. Plaintiffs' Motion for Service Awards, Attorneys' Fees and Costs is GRANTED.
2. Upon final approval of the class settlement and after release of the \$1.7 million settlement fund to the Settlement Administrator, the Settlement Administrator shall immediately distribute \$2,500 in settlement funds for service awards in accordance with the Settlement Agreement and Motion for Service Awards, Attorneys' Fees and Costs.
3. Attorney fees are awarded to class counsel, Community Justice Project and Fried Law Offices, in the amount of \$566,610. This amount, which constitutes a part of the total \$1.7 million settlement fund, shall be paid to the Settlement Administrator upon final

approval of the class settlement. The Settlement Administrator shall, after payment of pre-settlement costs to Community Justice Project in the amount of \$17,941.54, immediately distribute the remaining attorney fees in equal shares to the Community Justice Project and Fried Law Offices.
